FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE SAT®

? What is the SAT® and why should international students take it?

The SAT® is a standardized test widely used for college admissions in the United States and many other countries. Strong SAT scores can strengthen your application and sometimes qualify you for scholarships at U.S. universities and select international institutions.

? How do I register for the SAT® as an international student?

You can register online at the College Board website. When creating your account, choose your country and nearest test center. Be sure to register early, as international test centers often fill up quickly.

? How much does it cost to take the SAT® internationally?

As of now, the SAT® costs \$60 USD plus a \$43 USD international testing fee. Additional fees apply for late registration, changes, or extra score reports. Always check the College Board website for the most current pricing.

? Where can I take the SAT® outside the United States?

The SAT® is offered at approved international test centers, often located at international schools, American schools, or universities. You can search for the closest test center during registration.

? How often is the SAT® offered internationally?

International SAT® dates are usually in October, November, December, March, May, and June. Not all dates are available in every country, so confirm availability for your location when planning.

? What identification do I need on test day?

You must bring an acceptable photo ID, such as a passport or national ID card. The name on your ID must match the name on your SAT® admission ticket.

? How do I send my SAT® scores to universities?

When you register, you can select up to four colleges or universities to receive your scores for free. You can send additional reports later for an extra fee through your College Board account.

? Can I take the SAT® more than once?

Yes. Many students take the SAT® two or three times to improve their scores. Universities usually consider your highest score or “superscore” across test dates, depending on their policy.

? How should I prepare for the SAT® as an international student?

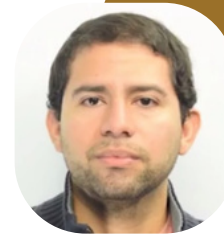

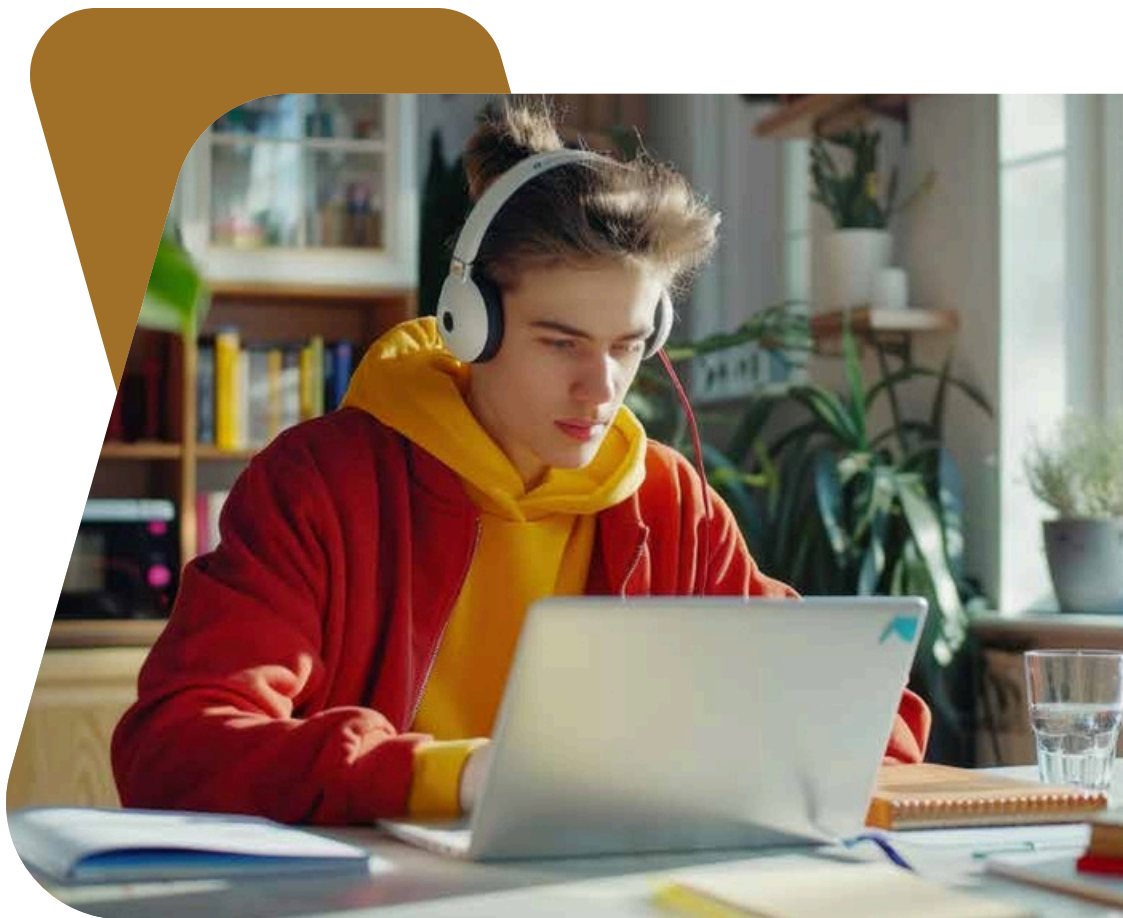
