HOW THE HOURS WORK

Students attend two 2-hour live classes each instructional week: Tuesday & Thursday, 6-8 PM UAE time, or Saturday & Sunday, 9-11 AM UAE time. Week 5 is reserved for personal study and a full-length practice opportunity; no live class is scheduled. Students complete 2-3 hours of targeted personal study for each class they attend.

Why Students Choose Math Only

Across the Gulf, students following a U.S. high school diploma pathway may need to demonstrate mathematics proficiency for graduation, certificate equivalency or university entry. English proficiency may be assessed separately through IELTS or another approved test. Requirements vary by country, education authority, school and graduation cohort, so families should confirm the current rules that apply to them.

Copperstone's five-week SAT Math Intensive is designed for students who need focused support in the Math section, whether to strengthen a U.S. diploma pathway, close specific skill gaps or pursue a higher SAT score. Instruction concentrates on essential foundations, high-value problem-solving, efficient calculator use, pacing and test strategy so students approach SAT Math with greater accuracy and confidence.

Frequently Asked Questions

The essentials, stated clearly.

01 Is the SAT relevant outside the United States?

Yes. More than 4,000 colleges and universities in the U.S. and 65+ other countries consider SAT scores. Each institution sets its own admissions policy, so students should verify requirements directly.

02 Are courses in person or online?

Copperstone SAT preparation is delivered live online by an instructor. Students join at the published UAE times and use the digital platform between classes for targeted practice.

03 How much time should a student plan?

Each instructional week includes two 2-hour live classes. Students also complete 2-3 hours of targeted personal study for each class, for a typical weekly commitment of 8-10 hours.

04 What happens during Week 5?

Week 5 is a personal study week with no live class. Students complete independent assignments, a full-length practice opportunity and structured error analysis.

05 What equipment is needed?

A reliable computer, stable internet connection, camera and microphone are required. Students should also have a calculator permitted for the digital SAT and use the official Bluebook testing application for College Board practice.

06 Does the course include SAT registration?

No. Families enroll in the Copperstone course and register for the official SAT separately through College Board. Registration deadlines are shown on each exam page.

07 Which course should we choose?

The full course is recommended for comprehensive Reading, Writing and Math preparation. The Math-only intensive suits students whose diagnostic results show that Math is the clear priority.

08 What does tuition cost?
